Re: Hole #8 Improvements

---

The Kapuskasing Golf Club (KGC) is proceeding with greenside improvements on hole #8.

The KGC will be collaborating with the Town of Kapuskasing (TOK) to remove five (5) willow trees and improve the visual character of #8. The trees interfere with the wireless communication signal of the TOK's lift station and water tower.

The KGC understands that the trees add to the character of the hole, but also understands that it has an opportunity to be proactive. Our willows are slowly achieving the end of their lifespan.

## Improvements

- Remove five (5) willow trees
- Plant seven (7) new trees
- Bring in fill, shape mounding behind the green, and seed
- Trees will be cut in July, and stumps/roots removed later on in the year so not to damage the green.



## Quick Facts

- The KGC has planted over 40 trees since 2012, and will continue to invest in trees over the next years.
