PM DRAW: FRONT 9 – **BLUE BLOCKS** BACK 9 – **WHITE BLOCKS**

**FOOD**

A ticket is provided to each player for a 1lb of wings on **SATURDAY** only. Sandwiches will be available to purchase throughout the weekend and the appetizer menu will be available from the bar.

#	AREA/ISSUE	RULE
1	FORMAT	<p><b>Saturday</b>  <i>Front 9 – Betterball.</i> Each golfer plays their own ball throughout the front 9 and after each hole, only the best score is recorded.  <i>Back 9 – Modified Scramble.</i> Each golfer hits their drive. If Player A's drive is chosen, then Player B hits the 2<sup>nd</sup> shot, Player A hits the 3<sup>rd</sup> shot, etc. until the ball settles on the green. Once on the green, both player can putt (scramble). <b><i>The ball chosen may not be replaced during play by the other player's ball.</i></b></p> <p><b>Sunday</b>            18 holes - Scramble</p>
2	WINTER RULES SATURDAY VS SUNDAY	<p><b>Saturday – Betterball &amp; Modified Scramble</b>            Preferred lies one (1) club length on your own fairway. All players must play the ball down in the rough or in another fairway.</p> <p><b>Sunday - Scramble</b>            Preferred lies one (1) club length through the green. Any player can play first. A ball in a penalty area (i.e. yellow or red stakes) must be played by the first player and the ball may not be moved. A ball in a bunker must be played by the 1<sup>st</sup> player as it lies. The 2<sup>nd</sup> player may rake and place within one scorecard length.</p>
3	LINED (WHITE) AREAS & ABONORMAL PLAYING AREAS	<p><b>"GROUND-UNDER-REPAIR" &amp; ABNORMAL PLAYING AREAS (TIRE MARKS, DAMAGED AREAS)</b>            Ball may be dropped within one club length of nearest point of relief. No closer to the hole. <b>NO PENALTY</b></p>
4	HOLE #5/#14 & #6/#15 (NEW)	The right side of holes #5/#14 and #6/#15 are now marked as red lateral penalty areas.
5	PROVISIONAL BALL – TO ENCOURAGE FAST PLAY	If you think you might have lost your ball (in an area that is not staked): <b>YOU MUST PLAY A PROVISIONAL BALL. THERE ARE NO SPOTTERS ON THE COURSE.</b>
6	WHEN IN DOUBT OF A RULING	Please play a second ball. A decision will be made after the completion of the round.
7	NEWLY PLANTED TREES WITH STAKES (TBARS/REBAR, ORANGE, OR PINK RIBBONS	<p>Must take free drop from <b>line of play*</b> and/or swing/stance. <b>NO PENALTY.</b>  <i>*Line of Play: Your ball flight must have a reasonable chance of contacting a newly planted tree. The other group must agree with line of play relief.*</i></p>
8	PACE OF PLAY	<p><b>PLEASE KEEP PACE BY FOLLOWING THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU CLOSELY.</b>            NOTE : Maximum of <b>three minutes</b> to find and identify your ball.</p>
9	IN THE EVENT OF A TIE, RETROGRESSION	<b>Best of last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes, last hole</b> – If a tiebreaker is needed to determine a champion, sudden death playoff will begin on hole #1, #2, #3, #6, #7, #8, #9 etc. (or at a location where there are no golfers on the course)
10	FOR RULINGS	Throughout the tournament, contact the rules committee ( <b>André Robichaud &amp; Luc St-Aubin</b> )
11	SCORES – FRONT NINE	Submit scorecard to the pro shop after hole #9.
12	SCORECARDS	Must be signed, and submitted to the scoring table <b>immediately after completing your round. Please make sure to match scorecards before submitting.</b>
13	STAKES AND PAINTED LINES	<p><b>WHITE STAKES &amp; PAINT LINES</b> - Out-of-bounds  <b>YELLOW STAKES &amp; PAINT LINES</b> - Penalty area  <b>WHITE PAINT LINES</b> - Ground-under-repair  <b>RED STAKES &amp; PAINT LINES</b> - Lateral penalty area</p>
14	WASTE BUNKERS	#2/#11 & #4/#13 left side fairway bunkers. Club may be grounded and winter rules apply (preferred lies - one club length)
15	CLOSEST TO THE PIN	Saturday & Sunday: Closest to the Pin #7/#16 & #9/#18
