

LOCAL RULES - Golf Canada Rules are in effect

MEN – Blue & White Blocks
WOMEN – Yellow & Red (Pink) Blocks

| # | AREA/ISSUE | RULE |
|----|--|--|
| 1 | WINTER RULES | Preferred lies, 1 club length through the green. The ball must stay in the same cut. Any player can play first. A ball in a penalty area (i.e. yellow or red stakes) must be played by the first player and the ball may not be moved. A ball in a bunker must be played by the first player and can be raked and placed. The second player must place the ball within a scorecard length of the original ball. |
| 2 | LINED (WHITE) AREAS & ABONORMAL PLAYING AREAS | “GROUND-UNDER-REPAIR” & ABNORMAL PLAYING AREAS (TIRE MARKS, DAMAGED AREAS) Ball may be dropped within one club length of nearest point of relief. No closer to the hole. NO PENALTY |
| 3 | HOLE #3 (#12) PENALTY AREA | If your ball goes into the penalty area (yellow stakes on the left) your choice of : a) playing the ball from the penalty area, NO PENALTY b) dropping the ball between the pin and where the shot was played, ONE STROKE PENALTY c) playing from where the shot was played, ONE STROKE PENALTY Behind the green (or any red lateral penalty area): choice a) playing from penalty area, NO PENALTY b) 2 club lengths from nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole, ONE STROKE PENALTY c) playing from where the shot was played, ONE STROKE PENALTY |
| 4 | PROVISIONAL BALL - TO ENCOURAGE FAST PLAY | If you think you might have lost your ball (in an area that is not staked): YOU MUST PLAY A PROVISIONAL BALL. THERE ARE NO SPOTTERS ON THE COURSE. |
| 5 | HOLE #5/#14 & #6/#15 (NEW) | The right side of holes #5/#14 and #6/#15 are now marked as red lateral penalty areas. |
| 6 | WHEN IN DOUBT OF A RULING | Please play a second ball. A decision will be made after the completion of the round. |
| 7 | NEWLY PLANTED TREES WITH STAKES (TBARS/REBAR, ORANGE, OR PINK RIBBONS) | Must take free drop from line of play* and/or swing/stance. NO PENALTY. <i>*Line of Play: Your ball flight must have a reasonable chance of contacting a newly planted tree. The entire group must agree with line of play relief.*</i> |
| 8 | FENCE #3/#12, #5/#14 & #8/#17 | Take free drop from line of play* and/or swing/stance. NO PENALTY. <i>*Line of Play: Your ball flight must have a reasonable chance of contacting the fence. The entire group must agree with line of play relief.*</i> |
| 9 | PACE OF PLAY | PLEASE KEEP PACE BY FOLLOWING THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU CLOSELY. NOTE : Maximum of three minutes to find and identify your ball |
| 10 | IN THE EVENT OF A TIE, RETROGRESSION | Best of last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes, last hole – If a tiebreaker is needed to determine a champion, sudden death playoff will begin on hole #1, #2, #3, #6, #7, #8, #9 etc. (Men – White blocks, women – red/pink blocks) |
| 11 | FOR RULINGS | Throughout the tournament, contact André Robichaud, Rules Official |
| 12 | SCORES – FRONT NINE | Submit your scorecard to the pro shop after hole #9. |
| 13 | SCORECARDS | Must be signed, and submitted to the pro shop immediately after completing your round. Please make sure to match scorecards before submitting. |
| 14 | STAKES AND PAINTED LINES | WHITE STAKES & PAINT LINES - Out-of-bounds YELLOW STAKES & PAINT LINES - Penalty area WHITE PAINT LINES - Ground-under-repair RED STAKES & PAINT LINES - Lateral penalty area |
| 15 | WASTE BUNKERS | #2/#11 & #4/#13 left side fairway bunkers. Club may be grounded and winter rules apply (preferred lies - one club length) |
| 16 | CLOSEST TO THE PIN | Saturday & Sunday: Closest to the Pin #7/#16 (Men) & #9/#18 (Women) |
| 17 | FEWEST PUTTS | Count your putts to win a prize (SATURDAY ONLY) |
| 18 | MULLIGANS | - Each player is allowed to use 2 mulligans. (SATURDAY ONLY) o Once a mulligan is declared and the ball is put into play, the previous shot by this player can still be used. A mulligan can be used only once by each player even if that shot was not used by the group. Once you declare a mulligan shot, you lose a mulligan ticket. o Submit your unused mulligan ticket(s) for a chance to win a prize. |
