LOCAL RULES - Golf Canada Rules are in effect

MEN – Blue & White Blocks

WOMEN – Yellow & Red (Green) Blocks

****All Decisions by the Rules Official Shall be Final****

#	AREA/ISSUE	RULE
1	WINTER RULES	Preferred lies, 1 club length through the green. <i>The ball must stay in the same cut.</i> Any player can play first. A ball in a penalty area (i.e. yellow or red stakes) must be played by the first player and the ball may not be moved. A ball in a bunker must be played by the first player. The second player must place the ball within a scorecard length of the original ball and is permitted to rake & place.
2	LINED (WHITE) AREAS & ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS	GROUND-UNDER-REPAIR / EQUIPMENT TIRE MARKS Ball may be dropped within one club length of nearest point of relief. No closer to the hole. All players must agree. NO PENALTY
3	HOLE #3 (#12) RED PENALTY AREA	Behind or the side of the green: choice a) playing from penalty area, NO PENALTY b) 2 club lengths from nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole, ONE STROKE PENALTY c) drop in nearest white painted drop area, ONE STROKE PENALTY
4	PROVISIONAL BALL – TO ENCOURAGE FAST PLAY	If you think you might have lost your ball (in an area that is not staked): YOU MUST PLAY A PROVISIONAL BALL. THERE ARE NO SPOTTERS ON THE COURSE. Players are encouraged to use the periscope on #2/#11, and cameras on #3/#12 and #6/#15.
5	WHEN IN DOUBT OF A RULING	Please play a second ball. A decision will be made after the completion of the round.
6	NEWLY PLANTED TREES WITH STAKES (TBARS)/REBAR, ORANGE, YELLOW OR PINK RIBBONS	Must take free drop from line of play* and/or swing/stance. NO PENALTY. *Line of Play: Your ball flight must have a reasonable chance of contacting a newly planted tree. The entire group must agree with line of play relief.*
7	FENCE #3/#12, #5/#14 & #8/#17	Take free drop from line of play* and/or swing/stance. NO PENALTY. *Line of Play: Your ball flight must have a reasonable chance of contacting the fence. The entire group must agree with line of play relief.*
8	PACE OF PLAY	PLEASE KEEP PACE BY FOLLOWING THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU CLOSELY. NOTE : Maximum of three minutes to find and identify your ball
9	IN THE EVENT OF A TIE, RETROGRESSION	Best of last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes, last hole – If a tiebreaker is needed to determine a champion, sudden death playoff will begin on hole #1, #2, #3, #6, #7, #8, #9 etc. (Men – White blocks, women – red/green blocks)
10	FOR RULINGS	Throughout the tournament, contact André Robichaud, Rules Official
11	SCORES – FRONT NINE	Submit your scorecard to the pro shop after hole #9.
12	SCORECARDS	Must be signed, and submitted to the pro shop immediately after completing your round. Please make sure to match scorecards before submitting.
13	STAKES AND PAINTED LINES	WHITE STAKES & PAINT LINES - Out-of-bounds (#8/#17). Stroke & distance or use nearest drop circle + 2 strokes YELLOW STAKES & PAINT LINES - Penalty area WHITE PAINT LINES - Ground-under-repair RED STAKES & PAINT LINES - Lateral penalty area
14	WASTE BUNKERS	#2/#11 & #4/#13 left side fairway bunkers. Club may be grounded and winter rules apply (preferred lies - one club length)
15	#9/#18 GREEN	You may move your ball on the green a scorecard length.
16	CLOSEST TO THE PIN	Saturday & Sunday: Closest to the Pin #7/#16 (Men) & #9/#18 (Women)
17	FEWEST PUTTS	Count your putts to win a prize (SATURDAY ONLY)
18	MULLIGANS	- Each player is allowed to use 2 mulligans. (SATURDAY ONLY) - Once a mulligan is declared and the ball is put into play, the previous shot by this player can still be used. <i>A mulligan can be used only once by each player</i> even if that shot was not used by the group. Once you declare a mulligan shot, you lose a mulligan ticket. - Submit your unused mulligan ticket(s) for a chance to win a prize.
