

7th Annual Kapuskasing Flyers Golf Tournament – June 12-14, 2026



LOCAL RULES - Golf Canada Rules are in effect

MEN – **Blue & White** Blocks

WOMEN – **Yellow & Red (Green)** Blocks

#	AREA/ISSUE	RULE
1	WINTER RULES	<i>Preferred lies</i> (pick and clean), <u>1 club length</u> through the green, except on the putting surface. Any player can play first. A ball in a penalty area (i.e., yellow or red stakes) must be <u>played by the first player and the ball may not be moved</u> . A ball in a bunker must be played by the first player <u>as it lies</u> . Other players can rake and place within a scorecard in the bunker, and within a scorecard in penalty areas.
2	LINED (WHITE) AREAS "GROUND-UNDER-REPAIR"	Ball may be dropped within one club length of nearest point of relief. NO PENALTY
3	HOLE #3 (#12) PENALTY AREA	If your ball goes into the penalty area (yellow or red stakes on the left) your choice of: a) playing from penalty area, NO PENALTY b) take relief between the point of entry and where the ball was originally played c) use one of the drop areas closer to the point of entry, ONE STROKE PENALTY Behind the green (or any red lateral penalty area): choice a) playing from penalty area, NO PENALTY b) 2 club lengths from the nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole, ONE STROKE PENALTY c) use one of the drop areas closer to the point of entry, ONE STROKE PENALTY
4	PROVISIONAL BALL TO ENCOURAGE FAST PLAY	If you think you might have lost your ball (in an area that is not staked): YOU MUST PLAY A PROVISIONAL BALL. NO SPOTTERS ON THE COURSE Players are encouraged to use the periscope on #2/#11, and cameras on #3/#12 and #6/#15.
5	WHEN IN DOUBT OF A RULING	Please play a second ball. A decision will be made after the completion of the round by the Tournament Committee.
6	NEWLY PLANTED TREES WITH TBARS/REBAR, ORANGE OR PINK RIBBONS	Must take free drop from <u>line of play*</u> and/or swing/stance. NO PENALTY. *Line of Play: Your ball flight must have a reasonable chance of contacting a newly planted tree. The other group must agree with line of play relief.*
7	STONE FILLED DRAINAGE DITCHES (#3/#12 AND #6/#15)	Relief may be taken. NO PENALTY
8	PACE OF PLAY	PLEASE KEEP PACE BY FOLLOWING THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU CLOSELY. NOTE: Maximum of 3 minutes to find and identify your ball
9	IN THE EVENT OF A TIE, RETROGRESSION	Best of last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes, last hole – back nine first, then front nine if required will be applied to determine flight winners. If a tiebreaker is needed to determine a champion, sudden death playoff will begin on hole # 1, 2, 3, 4, etc. from the Blue Blocks
10	SCORECARDS	Mobile Scoring (Smart Golf): All scoring will be completed through Smart Golf. Teams are responsible for verifying and matching scorecards before approving their online scorecard. Approved scores will be used for flighting and Sunday tee times. Any team that approves a score lower than its correct score will receive a two (2) stroke penalty added to its correct score.
12	STAKES AND PAINTED LINES	WHITE STAKES & PAINT LINES - Out-of-bounds YELLOW STAKES & PAINT LINES - Penalty area WHITE PAINT LINES - Ground-under-repair RED STAKES & PAINT LINES - Lateral penalty area
13	WASTE BUNKERS (#2/#11 & #4/#13 LEFT SIDE FAIRWAY BUNKERS)	#2/#11 & #4/#13 left side fairway bunkers. Club may be grounded, and winter rules apply (preferred lies - one club length)
14	ALCOHOL	Any team caught having a player under the legal drinking age (19 years old) drinking alcohol at the golf course will be subject to team expulsion of the tournament. An infraction of this rule will be reported to the KGC and may result in loss of membership privileges.
15	REPLACING A PLAYER (INJURY OR EMERGENCY SITUATIONS ONLY)	Unless there is an exceptional situation, changing a player during a round or between rounds will not be accepted. In an exceptional situation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The new player must have an equal or worst handicap, registered in a recognized handicap system. If this is not the case, the team will be asked to play with 2 players (2 shots only).
16	REDUCED PLAY DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER	The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reduce the tournament to 9 holes on Saturday or on Sunday to protect golfers from serious weather conditions. The committee's decision is final. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unless the HORN sounds for security reasons related to the weather play must continue. Championship Flight teams will finish 18 holes of play on Sunday (unless the horn sounds)
